CHAPTER I

Preliminary Ideas in Astrology

The preliminary ideas of Astrology are essential for proper understanding of Numerology.

Names of the Planets and their Symbols

With the help of Planets, Stars and Numbers astrologers and great sages have been predicting fortunes from times immemorial.

Ancient astronomers discovered the following seven planets.

Besides the above planets, there are two shadowy or fictitious planets-Rahu and Ketu. The former is also known as "The Moon's North Node" and the latter is known as "The Moon's South Node". Besides, the western astronomers have lately discovered three more planets-Uranus or Herschel, Neptune and Pluto.

Rulers of Zodiacal Signs, their Detriments, their Exaltation and their Fall

Ruler or tord:—Every zodiacal sign is ruled by a particular planet. It is called its ruler. The planet, in its own house, is powerful.

Detriment:—When the planet occupies the zódiacal sign opposite the sign of which it is the ruler, that sign is called its Detriment, eg., Mercury is the ruler of Gemini. The zodiacal sign, opposite to Gemini, is Sagittarius. Therefore, Sagittarius is the Detriment sign of Mercury. The planet, in its Detriment sign, is not powerful.

Exaltation:—There are certain zodiacal signs in which planets are very strong and powerful. When the planet is in such signs, it is said to be "Exalted" or "Ooch" e.g., Moon in Taurus.

Fall or Debilitation:—The zodiacal sign, opposite to the sign of the Exaltation of the planet, is called its sign of Debilitation or Fall.

The planet, in its sign of Fall, is very weak, e.g., Moon in Scorpio.

Sun Transitting Various Zodiacal Signs.

Numerology is designed for all people in general and not one particular individual. Hence we have considered here only the Sun, transitting various zodiacal signs and have left consideration of other planets.

'The Sun lives for one month in each zodfacal sign every year as under:—

In Aries :--From 23rd March to 23rd April. In Taurus :-From 23rd April to 23rd May. In Gemini :-From 23rd May to 23rd June. In Cancer :-From 23rd June to 23rd July, In Leo :—From 23rd July to 23rd August. In Virgo :-From 23rd August to 23rd September. In Libra :- From 23rd September to 23rd October. In Scorpio :--From 23rd October to 23rd November. In Sagittarius:-From 23rd November to 23rd December. In Capricorn:-From 23rd December to 23rd January. In Aquarius:—From 23rd January to 23rd February. In Pisces :- From 23rd February to 23rd March.

General Observation.

It is not our intention to drag the reader into the details and intricacies of astrology. Hence we have mentioned here the names of planets, the zodiacal signs, their rulers, their Detriments, their Exaltation and their Fall only. We have also given the periods of the year during which the Sun transits various zodiacal signs. The other planets transit the various zodiacal signs at different times according to their periods of revolution. Hence we have

not dealt with the transition of other planets in different zodiacal signs.

It is not possible to treat of the lucky number of the vast humanity living in this world because every human being is born under influences of different planets. Sun is exalted in Aries from 23rd March to 23rd April. Therefore the Sun is extremely powerful during this period. Again Sun is the ruler of Leo. Hence Sun is powerful from 23rd July to 23rd August every year, when Sun transits in Leo. Hence all persons, born during aforesaid periods, will easily understand that the number ruled by the Sun is beneficial for them. Similarly when the Sun transits Taurus, the House of Venus, from 23rd April to 23rd May, all persons, born during this period, will easily understand that the number ruled by Venus is beneficial for them. The same principle applies to other zodiacal signs.

In order to obtain the correct result as to which number is really the lucky number, governing each person, we should collect the following data of the individual concerned:—(i) Exact Time of Birth in Indian Standard Time, (ii) English Date, (iii) English Month, (iv) A. D. Year & (v) Place of birth. From these data a birth horoscope should be cast. From a close scrutiny of the horoscope we should find out the harmonious aspects formed at the time of birth and then determine the lucky number of each individual.

CHAPTER II.

Numbers from 1 to 9.

(a) General.

Zero (0) is not the number. It denotes "Infinity." The other numbers are: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9. There are seven days during a week. Each day is ruled by a particular planet, which is governed by a particular number as given below:—

From the above table you find that, besides the Su and Moon, each of the other five planets rules one number only. The Sun and the Moon have two numbers—of these one is operative in the bright half of the month *i.e.*, when the Moon waxes and the other is operative in the dark half of the month *i.e.*, when the Moon is waning. Numbers 1 & 7 operate in the dark half of the month, while numbers 2 & 4 operate in the bright half of the month.

Planetary Hours.

Although each day of a week is ruled by a particular planet, yet each hour of the day is ruled by a different

planet. The order is as follows:— (1) Saturn (2) Jupiter (3) Mars (4) Sun (5) Venus (6) Mercury (7) Moon. When the cycle of 7 hours is finished, another cycle of seven hours runs. After the Moon's rulership of the hours is finished, Saturn becomes the ruler of the hour. The above order should never be altered. Further ruling planet of a particular day is the ruler of first hour (from Sunnise) of that day. The other hours of the day are ruled by the succeeding planets in order given above.

We count the first hour from the time, the Sun rises. The time of Sun-rise is published in all daily papers, Ephemeris and Panchang. Suppose the time of Sun-rise, published in Hindustan Times, is 7-0 a. m. I. S. T. on Monday. The ruling planet of Monday is Moon. Hence Moon will be the ruler of first hour, from Sun-rise, of Monday. Thus Moon rules from 7-0 a. m. to 8-0 a. m. Therefore Moon is the dominating ruler of the first hour from Sun-rise. The other hours of Monday will, accordingly, be ruled by the succeeding planets in order given above. Thus the 2nd hour will be ruled by Saturn. Therefore from 8-0 a. m. to 9-0 a. m. Saturn and Moon are the joint rulers, one being the ruler of hour, while other being the ruler of the day. During the third hour from Sun-rise i. e., from 9-0 a.m. to 10-0 a.m., Jupiter along with Moon rules the hour and so on.

For ready reference we give below a table from which you can easily, ascertain the ruling planet of the hour of a particular day concerned:—

Method of finding out Planetary Hour from the above Table :—

1. When the given time, for which the ruler of the hour is required, falls between Sunrise and Noon, subtract the time of sunrise from the given time. This will show the number of hours elapsed since sunrise. Enter table

opposite this number in the left-hand column, and under the day of the week will be found the ruler of the hour.

2. When the given time, for which the ruler of the hour is required, falls any where between Noon and Mid-Night or Mid-Night and next sunrise, subtract the time of Sun-rise, from twelve hours and add to this the number of hours elapsed since noon upto the given time. This shows the number of hours elapsed since sun rise. Enter table at this number and proceed further as directed in paragraph 1.

Note—If the result, obtained from either of the above two rules shows hours and minutes enter at the hour to which the minutes belong. For example, in 16 hours 42 minutes, enter at the 17th hour. Always calculate the day as commencing from sunrise. Thus, 4th July, 4-0 a. m. should be counted from sunrise of the 3rd July.

Planetary Sub-Periods of Hour:-

Every hour is divided into 15 units of 4 minutes each. During each unit of 4 minutes the sub-rulership passes on to a different planet strictly in the order mentioned aforesaid.

For ready reference we give below a table from which you can easily find out the planetary sub-periods of an hour concerned.

How to find out Planetary Period from above table:-

After ascertaining the planetary hour, note the number of minutes which has elapsed of that hour, then enter the table of periods in the left hand column, marked "minutes" in each period and under the hour of the planet ruling at the time, and opposite the period within which the minutes fall, will be found the Planet ruling the Period at that time.

(b) Compound Numbers reduced to a Single Digit.

Compound numbers begin from 10 and onwards. They are known as compound numbers because they are made up of more than one digit. We shall discuss below the method of reducing compound number to a single digit or number.

Number 10 — 1+0 = 1 Number 11 — 1+1 = 2 Number 12 — 1+2 = 3 Number 13 — 1+3 = 4 Number 14 — 1+4 = 5 Number 15 — 1+5 = 6 Number 16 — 1+6 = 7 Number 17 — 1+7 = 8 Number 18 — 1+8 = 9 Number 19 — 1+9 = 10

From the above you will observe that the addition of the digits of the number 19 is equal to 1+9=10 which also a compound number. Besides, when the digits of the number 10 are added, the resultant is equal to 1+0=1. Thus the number 19 is really equivalent to number 1.

Similarly we take below some other compound numbers and illustrate the principle of reducing compound numbers to a single digit or number.

Rules.

From the above examples, we deduce the following rules for reducing the compound number to a single digit or number.

- (a) Add up all the digits of a given number. For example the two digits of 36 (3 & 6) are added up in the above illustration and the single digit arrived at by addition of 3+6 is 9 which is equivalent to compound number 36.
- (b) In case the addition of all the digits of a given number is a single digit, then that single digit is equivalent to the compound number e. g., 36=3+6=9. Here 9 is equivalent to compound number 36.
- (c) In case the addition of all the digits of a given number is equivalent to a compound number, then we should again add up the digits of that new compound number to reduce the new compound number to a single digit or number. The last single digit or number will be equivalent to the original number. Let us refer back to number

6789 mentioned above. Number 6789=6+7+8+9=30. The number 30 is again a compound number. The new compound number, when reduced to a single digit, is equal to 3+0=3, single digit or Number. Thus 3 is equivalent to original compound number, 6789.

(c) Numbers discussed individually.

Number 1.

The number 1 and Sunday are ruled by the Sun. Same compound numbers, when reduced to a single digit as per rules described in previous chapter, are also equivalent to number 1. Therefore persons, born either on 1st or on some dates, consisting of those compound numbers which, when reduced to a single digit or number, are equivalent to number 1, are ruled by number 1.

The Sun transits the zodiacal sign Aries, si gn of exaltation of Sun, between 23rd March and 23rd April and his own house Leo, between 23rd July and 23rd August of each year. A person, born during the above two periods of any year, will have number 1 as his probable lucky number. But if the person is born on 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th during the above two periods, then the number 1 is certainly his lucky number. In case the person is born on that hour of 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th during the aforesaid periods, in which the ruler of hour is Sun, then the lucky number 1 will have more astonishing effect. Such a person should do all his important work on 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th of any month and during the aforesaid two periods in particular but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Sun.

Further Sunday is ruled by the Sun. If Sunday happens to fall on 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid two periods, such a person should do all important work on these dates.

The number 4 is also ruled by the Sun. Therefore 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th dates of the month should prove lucky for such a person, specially if these dates fall on Sunday, but more specially during the aforesaid periods.

But the hour of Sun is generally unfortunate, particularly in asking favours of influential persons or for lending or borrowing money, or to commence any new work, or to enter a house for the first time, or to undertake a journey. Things lost or stolen in this hour are seldom recovered. Letters received during this time relate to affairs of credit and position and troubles connected therewith. Illness during this hour will be generally acute.

The Sun rules Golden or Orange colour. Hence if the persons, having number 1 as their lucky number, were to put on a ring with a diamond of aforesaid colour mounted on it, it should prove nice and lucky for them.

Note—The number 1 is operative in the dark half of the month i.e., when the Moon is waning.

Number 2.

The number 2 and Monday are ruled by the Moon. The compound numbers 11,20, and 29, when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to 2. Hence a person, born on 2nd, 11th, 20th or 29th of any month, is ruled by number 2.

The Sun transits the zodiacal sign Cancer, the house of the Moon, between 23rd June and 23rd lJuly. A person, born during the above period of any year, will have number 2 as his probable lucky number. But if the person is born on 2nd, 11th, 20th or 29th during the above period then the number 2 is certainly his lucky number.

Further Monday is ruled by the Moon. If Monday happens to fall on 2nd, 11th, 20th or 29th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid period, then such a person should do all important work on these dates.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Monday, during the above period, in which the ruler of hour is Moon, then the lucky number 2 will have most astonishing effect on the life of such a person. Such a person should do all his important work on 2nd, 11th, 20th, or 29th, falling on Monday during the aforesaid period, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Moon.

The number 7 is also ruled by the Moon. Therefore 7th, 16th, 25th dates of the month should prove lucky for such a person, specially if these dates fall on Monday and more specially during the aforesaid period.

The hour of the Moon is good for dealing with all public concerns, advertising, changes of all sorts, travels, etc. But it is not good in respect of matters dealing with females, or to take any important steps in respect of plans and arrangements. Things lost may be recovered if the facts are advertised publicly. Letters received relate to changes and are often of the nature of evasion. Illness during

this hour relates to complaints of stomach and digestion and also of chest affection.

The Moon rules "White Colour." Hence such a person; should put on white clothes as far as possible and avoid black dresses. A ring, with white pearl mounted on it, should prove lucky for him.

Note—The number 2 is operative in the bright half of the month i. e., when the Moon waxes.

Number 3.

Jupiter rules number 3 and week day, Thursday. The compound numbers 12, 21 and 30, when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to 3. Hence persons, born on 3rd, 12th, 21st and 30th of any month, are ruled by number 3.

The Jupiter rules the zodiacal signs—Sagittarius and Pisces. The Sun transits the zodiacal sign, Sagittarius between 23rd November and 23rd December, and the zodiacal sign, Pisces between 23rd February and 23rd March of each year respectively. Persons, born during the above periods of any year, will have number 3 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 3rd, 12th, 21st and 30th dates during the above periods, then number 3 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Thursday is ruled by Jupiter. In case Thursday happens to fall on 3rd, 12th, 21st and 30th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid periods, then such persons should plan and execute their important work on these dates.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Thursday during the above periods, in

which the ruler of hour is Jupiter then the lucky number 3 of that person will have most astonishing effects on him. Such a person should plan and execute all his important work on 3rd, 12th, 21st of 30th, falling on Thursday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Jupiter.

The hour of Jupiter is good for obtaining favours from superiors and persons in authority and position; for travels and new enterprises; for marriage; for obtaining legal advice; for lending and borrowing money. It is lucky or fortunate for all pecuniary transactions and commerce in general; for advancing one's interest in any direction. However, it is unfortunate for dealing in cattles. Stolen things will be recovered if the fact is advertised publicly with some reward. Letters received during this hour will have reference to money, trade, etc., and always prove advantageous to the person receiving them. Information received at this time is generally reliable. Illness during this hour shows a rapid recovery.

The colour ruled by Jupiter is yellow. Hence such a person should put on yellow clothes in preference to others as far as possible. A ring with yellow "Topaz" mounted on it should prove lucky for him.

Sun rules number 4 and week day, Sunday. The compound numbers 13, 22, and 31, when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to 4. Hence persons, born on 4th, 13th, 22nd and 31st of any month, are ruled by number 4.

Sun rules the zodiacal sign—Leo, while the sign of exaltation of Sun is Aries. The Sun transits the zodiacal sign Aries between 23rd March and 23rd April and the zodiacal sign, Leo between 23rd July and 23rd August of each year respectively. Persons, born during the above periods of any year, will have number 4 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 4th, 13th, 22nd and 31st during the aforesaid periods, then number 4 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Sunday is ruled by Sun. In case Sunday happens to fall on 4th, 13th, 22nd and 31st of lany month, but particularly during the aforesaid iperiods, then such persons should plan and execute their important work on these dates.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Sunday during the above periods, in which the ruler of hour is Sun then the lucky number 4 of that person will have most astonishing effect on him. Such a person should plan or execute all his important work on 4th, 13th, 22nd or 31st, falling on Sunday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Sun.

It is my personal experience that persons having their ruling number 4 are not so lucky as persons having their ruling number 1 which is also ruled by Sun as described in previous pages. If persons, having number 4 as their lucky number, plan and execute their important work on 1st, 10th, 19th and 28th, falling on Sunday during the aforesaid periods, instead of on 4th, 13th, 22nd and

31st (on the same week day and during the same periods) they will meet with greater success.

Note—The number 4 is operative in the bright half of the month i. e., when the Moon waxes.

Number 5.

Mercury rules number 5 and weekday, Wednesday. The compound numbers 14 & 23, when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to 5. Hence persons born on 5th, 14th, and 23rd of any month are ruled by number 5.

Mercury rules the zodiacal signs—Gemini and Virgo. The Sun transits the zodiacal sign, Gemini between 23rd and 23rd June and the zodiacal sign, Virgo between 23rd August and 23rd September every year respectively. Persons, born during the above periods of any year, will have number 5 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 5th, 14th, and 23rd dates during the above periods, then number 5 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Wednesday is ruled by Mercury. In case Wednesday happens to fall on 5th, 14th and 23rd of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid periods, then such persons should plan and execute their important work on these dates.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Wednesday during the above periods, in which the ruler of hour is Mercury then the lucky number 5 of that person will have most astonishing effects on him. Such a person should plan and execute all his important

work on 5th, 14th or 23rd, falling on Wednesday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Mercury.

The hour of Mercury is good for buying or selling, in writing letters, to commence any study and to deal in matters connected with children or young people. Things lost generally prove to have been stolen but may be recovered. Letters received relate to business and trade, educational matters, writings, papers and matters affecting young persons. Illness will generally be of nervous nature and will fluctuate.

Mercury rules green colour. A ring, with a stone of green or pale green colour mounted on it, should profit lucky for them.

Number 6.

Venus rules number 6 and week day, Friday. The compound numbers 15, 24 when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to 6. Hence persons born on 6th, 15th and 24th of any month are ruled by number 6.

Venus rules the zodiacal signs—Taurus and Libra. The Sun transits the zodiacal sign, Taurus between 23rd April and 23rd May and the zodiacal sign Libra between 23rd September and 23rd October every year respectively. Persons, born during the above periods of any year, will have number 6 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 6th, 15th and 24th dates during the above periods, then number 6 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Friday is ruled by Yenus In case Friday hopens to fall on 6th, 15th and 24th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid periods, then such persons should plan and execute their important work on these dates specially.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Friday during the above periods, in which the ruler of hour is Venus then the lucky number 6 of that person will have most astonishing effects on him. Such a person should plan and execute all his important work on 6th, 15th or 24th, falling on Friday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Venus.

The hour of Venus is a good hour for domestic affairs, courting women, marriage, commencing a journey, to visit friends, to undertake any business or sport, to take medicine, to occupy a new house, to purchase furniture, jewellery and for the pursuit of things of pleasure and fashion. Things lost may be easily recovered. Letters received will generally relate to pleasure and gain. Illness during this hour shows a rapid recovery.

Venus rules white colour. Hence such persons should put on white clothes as far as possible and avoid using black dresses. A ring, with white pearl mounted on it, should prove lucky for them.

Number 7.

Moon rules number 7 and week day, Monday. The numbers 2 and 7 are interchangeable numbers. The compound numbers 16 and 25, when reduced to a single digit

or number, are also equivalent to 7. Hence persons born on 7th, 16th and 25th of any month are ruled by number.

Moon rules the zodiacal sign—Cancer. The Sun transits Cancer between 23rd June and 23rd July every year. Persons, born during the above period of any year, will have number 7 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 7th, 16th and 25th dates during the above period, then number 7 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Monday is ruled by Moon. In case Monday happens to fall on 7th, 16th and 25th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid period, then such persons should plan and execute their important work specially on these dates.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Monday during the above period, in which the ruler of hour is Moon then the lucky number 7 of that person will have most astonishing effects on him. Such a person should plan and execute all his important work on 7th, 16th or 25th dates, falling on Monday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of ates when the ruler of hour is Moon.

The number 2 is also ruled by the Moon. Hence number 2 is lucky for persons born on 2nd, 11th, 20th or 29th dates, falling on Monday during the aforesaid period, but specially in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Moon.

Note—The number 7 is operative in the dark half of the month i. e., When the Moon is waning.

Number 8.

Saturn rules number 8 and week day, Saturday. The compound numbers 17 and 26, when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to 8. Hence persons born on 8th, 17th and 26th of any month are ruled by number 8.

Saturn rules the zodiacal signs—Capricorn and Aquarius. The Sun transits the zodiacal sign, Capricorn between 23rd December and 23rd January and the zodiacal sign, Aquarius between 23rd January and 23rd February every year respectively. Persons, born during the aforesaid periods of any year, will have number 8 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 8th, 17th and 26th dates, during the above periods, then number 8 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Saturday is ruled by Saturn. In case Saturday happens to fall on 8th, 17th and 26th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid periods, then such persons should plan and execute their important work on these dates specially.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Saturday during the above periods, in which the ruler of hour is Saturn then the lucky number 8 of that person will have most astonishing effects on him. Such a person should plan and execute all his important work on 8th, 17th or 26th, falling on Saturday, during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of af oresaid dates when the ruler of hour is Saturn.

Like the number 4, the number 8 is not a happy number. Moreover, the numbers 4 and 8 are interchangeable.

Persons born on 8th, 17th and 26th of any month should avoid living in a house which bears number 4 or 8 or any compound number which when reduced to a single digit or number is equal to 4 or 8. Such persons are, however, advised to reside in a house bearing number 3 or 6.

The hour of Saturn is an evil hour. It is bad for almost all affairs. It is bad for travels, voyages, starting new enterprises, employment of servants, taking medicine, borrowing and lending money. However, it is good for taking leases of houses or lands, for purchasing any kind of grain for cultivation and for matters connected with the produce of the soil such as crops and minerals; for dealing with the aged and infirm, for contracts reaching over many years. Things lost during this hour are seldom regained and may be found only after long delay. Letters received in this hour relate to death, sickness, misfortune and delays. Illness during this hour will indicate a long period of suffering and will only recover after much care and expense.

Saturn rules deep blue or Indigo colour. Hence persons, ruled by number 8, should put on a ring, with stone of deep blue colour mounted on it and it should prove good for them.

Number 9.

Mars, rules number 9, and weekday, Tresday, The compound numbers 18&27, when reduced to a single digit or number, are also equivalent to pumber 9.50 Hance operations hope of the single digit of numbers 18th, and 27th, of any, month are ruled by number 3.

Mars rules the zodiacal signs—Aries and Scorpio. The Sun transits the zodiacal sign, Aries between 23rd March and 23rd April and the zodiacal sign, Scorpio between 23rd October and 23rd November every year respectively. Persons, born during the above periods of any year, will have number 9 as their probable lucky number. But if the persons are born on 9th, 18th and 27th dates during the above periods, then number 9 is certainly their lucky number.

Further Tuesday is ruled by Mars. In case Tuesday happens to fall on 9th, 18th and 27th of any month, but particularly during the aforesaid periods, then such persons should plan and execute their important work on these dates specially.

In case the person is born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Tuesday during the above periods, in which the ruler of hour is Mars then the lucky number 9 of that person will have most astonishing effects on him. Such a person should plan and execute all his important work on 9th, 18th or 27th, falling on Tuesday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Mars.

The hour of Mars is bad for undertaking any enterprise or travel. It is an evil hour and should be avoided for all purposes. Hurry and impulsiveness in all actions, quarrels and disputes should be avoided. Things lost are usually found immediately or not at all. Information received or impressions coming to the brain during this hour are unreliable. Letters received during this hour oferetnlate to disputes, fraud, accidents, etc. Illness during this hour will be usually violent and acute.

Mars rules Red colour. Hence such persons should put on a ring, with a red stone mounted on it, for success in life.

CHAPTER III

The Compound Numbers and the Name or Fate Numbers.

(a) General.

Numbers 1 to 9 and zero (0) are all elementary numbers. The compound numbers, e.g., 20, 45, 401, 4597, 12358, etc., are formed by the combination of elementary numbers.

The compound numbers 10, 14, 17, 19, 20, 21, 23, 24, 25, 27 are good and lucky numbers in general. But the compound numbers 11, 13, 15, 16, 18, 22, 26, 28, 29 are unlucky numbers in general.

We shall now discuss how you should find out your Name or Fate Number which may prove important in your life. Every letter of English Alphabet is assigned a different value. These values have already been fixed by the ancient sages and Religionists for their divine purposes.

The following values were first adopted by the Egyptians:—

If this man is born on 9th, 18th & 27th of any month but specially if he is born on the above dates falling on Tuesday, which is ruled by Mars and more specially be tween the periods i.e., 23rd March and 23th April; and 23rd October and 23rd November of any year when the Sun transits the Zodiacal signs—Aries and Scorpio then it is 100% certain that the number 9 will rule him. If such a person reviews the record of his past life, he would observe that most probably the outstanding events in his life must have taken place

on 9th, 18th and 27th of the month. Such a person-should do all important work on 9th, 18th and 27th of any month but more specially if these dates fall on Tuesday and during the aforesaid two periods of the year.

Example: 2. Kishori Lal

Thus number 1 is the Ruling or Fate number of Kishori Lal. Number 1 should influence Kishori Lal. Number 1 is ruled by Sun. If this man is born on 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th of any month but specially if these dates fall on Sunday, which is ruled by Sun and more specially between the periods i. e., 23rd March and 23rd April; and 23rd July and 23rd August of any year when the Sun transits the Zodiacal signs—Aries and Leo, then it is cent percent certain that the number 1 will rule him. If such a person reviews the record of his. past life, he would observe that the outstanding events in his life must have most probably taken place on 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th of the month. Such a person should do all his important work on 1st, 10th, 19th or 28th of any month but more specially if these dates fall on Sunday and during the aforesaid two periods of the year.

Rule—We deduce the following rule from the above examples:—

"When the Fate Number and Birth date is the same, you should consider that this number governs your life favourably even though the number is not a fortunate one."

Example 3.

(a) Kishori Lal wants to know whether he will be successful in service or not.

We should find out the number of word "Service" as explained in Example 1 & 2 in previous pages. "Service" is equal to number 3.

As explained in Example 2, Kishori Lal's fate number is 1.

Now we consult table No. 4 and find that number 1 is friend to Number 3. Hence Kishori Lal may be successful in service.

(h) Now Kishori Lal wants to know whether he will be successful in business or not.

As explained in Example (3 a) we find that the word "business" is equivalent to number 1.

On consulting table No. 4 we find that number 1 is ordinary to number 1. Hence Kishori Lai will gain ordinarily in business.

(c) Again Kishori Lal wants to know whether he will be successful in contractorship or not.

As explained above we find that the word "contractorship" is equivalent to number 4.

Referring to table No. 4 we find that number 1 is ordinary to number 4. Hence Kishori Lal will gain ordinarily in contractorship.

(d) Kishori Lal wants to marry with Shakuntala and therefore he is eager to know whether he will be successful or not in marriage.

As explained above we find that the word "Shakuntala" is equivalent to number 1 and word "Marriage" is equivalent to number 5.

Referring to table No. 4 we find that the number 1 is ordinary to number 1 and friend to number 5. Hence there is no harm if Kishori Lal marries Shakuntala. The love will be ordinary, but friendly.

(c) Kishori Lal appeared in B. A. examination, held from 26th March 1950. He wants to know whether he will be successful or not in the examination.

As explained above we find that the words "B. A. Examination" are equivalent to number 9, while as per our table number 3, 26th March is equivalent to number 5 and 1950=1+9+5+0=15=6. Thus 26th March 1950 is equal to number 6+5=11=1+1=2.

Referring to table number 4 we find that number 1 is ordinary to number 9, while number 1 is friend to number 2. So Kishori Lal will pass with ordinary numbers.

(f) Kishori Lal wants to know whether he will be successful as Doctor or as a Road-Engineer.

As explained in previous pages we find that the word "Doctor" is equivalent to number 4, while the word "Road-Engineer" is equivalent to number 5.

On consulting table number 4 we find that number 1 is ordinary to number 4 while the number 1 is friend to number 5. So Kishori Lal will be more successful as a "Road-Engineer" than as a Doctor.

(g) Kishori Lal wants to know whether he will get profit in farmership or not.

"Farmership" is equivalent to number 4.

Referring to table No. 4, you will observe that the number 1 is ordinary to number 4. Hence Kishori Lal will gain ordinarily in farmership.

(h) Kishori Lal bought a Durby Lottery Ticket, opening on 25th November, 1950. The question is whether he would have gained something or not?

Adding all these numbers we get compound number 12, which when reduced to a single digit is equivalent to number 3.

Referring to table number 4, you will observe that the number 1 is friend to number 3. Hence Kishori Lal must have got a good prize. (i) M/s Chimman Lal Tejmal, a firm, wants to know which business, either of Gold, Silver or Cotton, will be profitable to them.

Now we find the numbers of words as below as explained previously:—

Chimman Lal Tejmal=Number 8

Gold = ,, 9
Silver = ,, 7
Cotton = ... 5

Referring to table number 4, our result is as follows:—

Gold -Number 8 is friend to number 9. Hence the firm will get good profits in gold business.

Silver-Number 8 is friend to number 7. Hence the firm expects to get good profits in silver business.

Cotton—Number 8 is ordinary to number 5. Hence the firm expects to get ordinary profits in Cotton business.

(j) Govind Prashad has a disease of Dropsy. Will he get through this disease or not?

As explained previously we find that the word "Govind Prashad" is equivalent to number 5, while the word "Dropsy" is equivalent to number 4.

Referring to table number 4, we observe that the number 5 is enemy to number 4. Hence it is difficult for Govind Prashad to get through this disease.

(k) Kishori Lal wants to send entry for Cross Word in Illustrated weekly of India, appearing on 1st

August 1954. The question is whether he will gain some prize or not?

Now we find the numbers of words as below as explained in previous pages:—

Referring to table number 4, we observe that number 1 is enemy to number 8. Hence it is difficult for Kishori Lal to get prize in this cross word.

(1) Kishori Lal has learnt that there is some hidden wealth in his house at Gwalior. He wants to know if he will be able to get the hidden wealth or not.

Now we find the numbers of words as below as explained in previous pages.

Hidden wealth = Number 9

Gwalior = ,, 8

Adding these numbers we get compound number 17, which when reduced to a single digit or number is equivalent to number 8.

Referring to table number 4, we observe that number 1 is enemy to number 8. Hence it is difficult for Kishori Lal to get hidden wealth. (m) Shyam Lal Pandaviya wants to fight ministership of Madhya Bharat Legislative Assembly, to be held in year 1951. The question is whether he will be successful or not?

Shyam Lal Pandaviya's fate number will be 1, while the numbers of other words are given below:—

Ministership = Number 8

Madhya Bharat = ,, 3

Legislative = ,, 2

Assembly = ,, 1

Year 1951 = ,, 7

Adding all these numbers we get compound number 21, which when reduced to a single digit or number is equivalent to number 3.

Referring to table number 4, we observe that number 1 is friend to number 3. Hence Shyam Lal Pandaviya is sure to become a Minister.

(n) Both Shri Mishri Lal Gangwal and Shri Takhat Mal Jain want to fight for the portfolio of Chief Minister in Madhya Bharat Legislative Assembly to be held in 1952. The question is who will be successful?

Mishri Lal Gangwal's fate number, is 8 and Takhat Mal Jain's fate number is 2. The numbers of other words are given below:—

Chief = Number 7

Minister = ,, 3

Madhya Bharat = ,, 3

Legislative = ,, 2

Assembly = ,, 1

Year 1952 = ,, 8

Adding all these numbers we get compound number 24, which when reduced to a single digit or number is equivalent to number 6.

Now referring to table number 4, we observe that number 8 (Mishri Lal Gangwal's fate number) is friend to number 6. Hence he is sure to become Chief Minister. Again, Number 2 (Takhat Mal Jain's fate number) is ordinary to number 6. Hence he is not certain to become Chief Mininister.

(o) Both Shri Gautam Sharma and Shri Narain Rao Bhashkar Khare want to stand for the membership of Lok Sabha, to be held in 1952, The question is who will be successful?

Shri Gautam Sharma's fate number is 7 and Shri Narain Rao Bhashkar Khare's fate number is 1. The numbers of other words are given below:

Membership = Number 2

Lok Sabha = ,, 4

Year 1952 = ,, 8

Adding all these numbers we get compound number 14, which when reduced to a single digit or number is equivalent to number 5.

Now referring to table number 4 we observe that number 7 (Gautam Sharma's fate number) is enemy to number 5. Hence he is sure to be defeated. But number 1 (Narain Rao Bhashkar's fate number) is friend to number 5 Hence he is sure to be elected.

(p) Shri Kishori Lal wants to construct a building at Lashkar. The question is whether he will be able to construct or not?

Kishori Lal's fate number is 1. The numbers of other words are given below:—

Building = Number 7

Lashkar = , 7

Adding all these numbers we get compound number 14, which when reduced to a single digit or number is equivalent to number 5.

Now referring to table number 4, you will find that number 1 is friend to number 5. Hence Kishori Lalwill construct a building at Lashkar.

CHAPTER IV

Planets and their Relations with one another and

Their Interchangeable Numbers & their Periodicity

The sun, the Moon, Jupiter and Mars are friends in the heavenly cabinet. Their numbers are 1, 4, 2, 7, 3 and 9. Out of these numbers, the number 4 is an unfortunate number. The remaining five numbers 1, 2, 7, 3 and 9 are interchangeable numbers because they have harmonious vibrations with one another.

Mercury, Venus and Saturn are friends in the heavenly cabinet. Their numbers are 5, 6 and 8. Number 8 is an unfortunate number. Hence it can be safely interchanged with numbers 5 and 6. Suppose the fate number of a person is 8. If such a person is born when the Sun passes through Zodiacal signs—Gemini and Virgo, ruled by Mercury—and Taurus and Libra ruled by Venus, he can safely adopt number 5 or 6 to give favourable results.

The Sun and Mars are dead enemies of Saturn. Their numbers are 1, 4, 9 and 8. These numbers do not vibrate favourably with one another, and therefore should not be interchanged with 1, 4 and 9 at any cost.

Venus is the enemy of the Sun, the Moon, Jupiter and Mars. Their numbers are 6 and 1, 4, 2, 7, 3 and 9. The number 6, which is ruled by Venus, should not be interchanged with number 1, 4, 2, 7, 3 and 9 at any cost and under any case.

Periodicity of each planet is the number ruled by that planet. You should first see which important number has played an important part, whether for good or evil, in your past life. Suppose number 5 has played an important part for good in your past life. Then some important good work will be repeated in your life time, every 5th year. But if some important evil work has been done, then some important evil work will be repeated in your life time, every 5th year. Similarly number 7 has played an important part for good or for evil, then every 7th year some important good or evil work will be repeated in your life time.

Some Sound Instructions Regarding Numbers

- (1) You should first find out the name or fate number which rules you and also whether the name accords with your birth date and birth day. Hit does not agree, make either a slight change in the spelling of your name or adopt a new name altogether which should vibrate harmoniously with the birth date and birth day.
- (2) Keep such a name of your business establishment, e.g., shop of office etc., as may vibrate harmoniously with your favourable fate or name number. The opening ceremony of such business establishment should be performed on the favourable date in accordance with your name number.
- (3) You should do your business in that city whose number should accord with your name number.
- (4) If you observe that your name number repeates itself unfavourably on these dates in your life, then change that name number as suggested above.

- (5) Suppose your name number is 4. If number 4 repeates itself in important events in your life unfavourably, make a change in your name so that your name number be 1 (as number 4 harmoniously vibrates with number 1). Do not live in a house or carry on your business in premises bearing number 4. But you should always endeavour to live in a house or carry on your business in premises bearing number 1 or 10, or 19 or 28.
- (6) Suppose your name number is 8. If number 8 repeates itself in important events in your life unfavourably, introduce a change in your name so that your name aumber be 6 (as number 8 harmoniously vibrates with number 6). Do not live in a house or carry on your business in premises bearing number 8. But you should always endeavour to live in a house or carry on your business in premises bearing number 6, or 15 or 24.
- (7) Always plan and execute your important work on dates of the month corresponding to your name number.

CHAPTER V

Application of Numbers to Lotteries (Lotteries Numerology)

(a) General

A good number of persons sink their fortune in Lotteries. But very few persons are lucky to win it. Sometimes very poor persons also get good prizes in lottery. But if you cast horoscopes of such poor persons, you will observe in their horoscopes certain outstanding Astrological Yogas which made them rich cheaply. Hence when a man seeks your advice whether he will be successful in Lottery or not, you should, first of all, east his birth horoscope according to Sayana System. Thereafter you should read the horoscope minutely according to rules laid down in some standard Astrological book. These astrological rules, if applied honestly to read the birth horoscope, may predict clearly what is in store for a man in days to come in his life. If by reading the birth horoscope of the person in question, you observe that there are some outstanding Astrological yogas, in his horoscope, which may make him rich cheaply and specially if there are good harmonious aspects either between the Moon or the Sun and Uranus or Herschel, you should expect that he may win the first prize in lottery when he passes through the favourable Mahadasha during his life.

Outstanding Astrological Yogas helping Success in Lottery

For ready reference of readers we give below some oustanding Astrological yogas, occurring in Horoscopes,

which may make the native rich cheaply. Such yogas certainly help the native to get money cheaply either by Lottery or some other means.

- (i) Moon in Ascendant at birth in Zodiacal signs—Aries, Taurus, Cancer and Capricorn.
- (ii) Jupiter in Zodiacal signs—Aries, Cancer, Leo, Scorpio, Sagittarius—occupying the 1st, 4th, 5th or 9th House of native's Horoscope.
- (iii) Venus in Zodiacal signs Taurus, Scorpio, Pisces-occupying the 8th, 9th or 11th House.
- (iv) Saturn in Zodiacal signs-Libra, Capricorn or Aquarius-occupying 4th, 7th, or 11th House.
- (v) Moon, Mercury, Jupiter, Venus in Zodiacal signs—Taurus, Cancer, Scorpio, Capricorn, Aquarius—occurring in 5th or 8th House in Native's Horoscope.
- q (vi) Jupiter in Cancer in the fourth House, Saturn in Libra in the Seventh House, Venus in Scorpio in Eighth House.
- (vii) Jupiter in Sagittarius in 9th House, Mars in Capricorn in 10th house.
- (viii) Moon in Leo in Ascendant at birth, Saturn in Aquarius. If Sun, Jupiter and Mars occupy the House of profit in native's horoscope, these planets will further strengthen the aforesaid yoga. Special benefit will accrue to the native in this yoga, if Sun, Jupiter or Mars form either a Trine or Square aspect with Moon, Venus or Mercury.
- (ix) Moon in Capricorn in Ascendant at birth, Jupiter in Aries or Cancer in the fourth House, Saturn or Mercury in House of wealth.
 - (x) Mercury and Venus in Aquarius, occupying

the Eighth House. In this yoga conjunction of Moon and Mars is necessary.

Aspects indicating Success in Lottery.

- (a) Jupiter and Moon in Cancer, forming Sextile 60° aspects in Second or Eleventh House. In this aspect the native will get first prize amounting to Rs. 6,00,000/-
- (b) Jupiter and Moon in Cancer or Taurus, forming Trine 120° aspect in 4th or 9th House. This aspect will indicate that the native will get first prize.
- (c) Sun and Moon in Cancer or Leo, forming Sextile 60° aspect in 4th or 10th House will give the native first prize.
- (d) Sun and Herschel in Aries; or moon and Herschel in Taurus, forming Trine aspect in 11th House will give the native first prize.
- (e) Saturn and Venus in Libra, forming Sextile or Trine aspect in Third, Sixth or Eleventh House, will yield the native Second prize.
- (f) Mars in Capricorn forming Sextile or Trine aspect with Moon or Jupiter in 3rd or 10th house will yield the native Second prize.
- (g) Jupiter and Moon in Taurus or Cancer, forming Semi-sextile aspect in 2nd or 8th house will yield the native Third prize.
- (h) Sun and Moon in Aries or Leo; and Moon and Herschel in Taurus or Cancer, forming Semi-sextile 30° aspect in 5th, 9th or 11th house, indicate that the native-will get the third prize.
- (i) Jupiter and Moon in Cancer or Taurus; Saturn and Mars in Libra or Capricorn, forming Semi-sextile 30° aspect in: Second, Third or Tenth house will yield the native third prize.

Data for Casting Accurate Horoscope: -

For casting accurate Birth Horoscope, you require the following data:---

(i) Exact time of birth according to Greenwich or Standard time of your country, (ii) English date or Hindi tithi, month and the year of birth (iii) Place of birth, (iv) and Country born in.

Besides, attempting to become rich by winning lottery, a correct reading of an accurate horoscope will suggest you the correct name, number and week day, you may safely adopt to bring speces in your business and when you should plan and execute your important works for success.

In the previous chapter I have discussed numbers in general in its application to human beings and not in particular in its application to any particular individual,

I may strongly advise my readers not to sink much money in lotteries by banking on numbers enumerated by me in previous chapters because the rules discussed by me are general in application to the vast humanity and not to particular individual. In case you want to sink a good proportion of your capital in lotteries, you are advised to seek my advice individually by writing to me all the details required for casting horoscopes. Such details as required for horoscopes, are given above.

(b) Rules for Application of Numbers to Lotteries.

(1) First of all find out the date of the month. wou are born. Suppose you are born on 5th or 14th or 22rd of any month. Then you are ruled by number 5 mich will be your Fate or Name Number.

- (2) Now find out the week day of the month you are born. If the week day is Wednesday which is ruled by number 5, then it is certain that number 5 will play important part in your life. Even if you are born on the week day Friday i.e., day of Venus or the week day Saturday i.e., day of Saturn, still number 5 will play an important role in your life in as much as Mercury, Venus and Saturn are friends in the Heavenly cabinet.
- (3) Again, if the birth dates 5th, 14th or 23rd and the week day of the birth, Wednesday happen to fall during the periods of the year when the Sun transits the Zodiacal sign, Gemini between 23rd May and 23rd June and the zodiacal sign, Virgo between 23rd August and 23rd September every year, then number 5 will definitely play an important part in your life.
- (4) Further if you are born on that hour of aforesaid dates, falling on Wednesday during the above two periods as mentioned in Rule 3 above, in which the ruler of hour is Mercury, then your lucky number 5 will have most astonishing effects on you. You should plan and execute all your important work on 5th, 14th or 23rd, falling on Wednesday during the aforesaid periods, but more particularly in that hour of aforesaid dates when the ruler of hour is Mercury.
- (5) However, it may be noted that it is not possible that all the above four factors should coincide. But even if two or three of these four rules coincide, then you must bank on number 5 as your lucky or Fate number.
- (6) The same principles apply to other numbers, and then find out the number which influences success

in your life and bank on the number so found out accordingly.

- (7) Besides the above rules, write your full name and then put down the alphabetical values of your name and find out the Name or Fate number as explained in Chapter III. If this name number agrees with the number of the birth date, week day and the periods of the year as explained in Rule number 3, then you can safely bank on this name number. Bu if this name number does not agree as above, then make such a minor change—either in he spelling of your name or altogether in your namethat the name number of the altered name coincides with your birth date, week day and the periods of the year as mentioned in Rule 3. Similar rule will apply to other numbers.
- (8) After determining your Name or Fate number you should select the Lottery number whose first digit synchronises with your Name number. Further you should try to see that the whole lottery ticket number, when reduced to a single digit or number, also coincides with your Name number. Suppose your Name number is 5. You should buy a lottery ticket whose first digit synchronises with your Name number 5 and also the whole lottery ticket number, when reduced to a single digit, coincides with your name number 5. Hence you should buy a lottery ticket, bearing number like 20165, because the first digit is 5 and when the whole lottery ticket number 20165 is reduced to a single digit or the single number, the final number is also 5 which coincides with the lucky number. Further you should buy this lottery ticket on

Wednesday which is ruled by number 5. Besides all this if this lottery ticket is purchased during the periods mentioned in rule 3 and on Wednesday, the result will be most encouraging.

- (9) If you purchase a lottery ticket in which the first two digits of the lottery number should win the first prize, please follow the rules detailed below:—
- (a) Buy that lottery ticket of which unit's digit agrees with your name number.
- (b) Buy that lottery ticket of which the unit's digit as well as ten's digit, when reduced to a single digit coincides with your name number.
- (c) Buy that lottery ticket of which the unit's digit, ten's digit and also all the digits of lottery ticket, taken together and reduced to a single digit, coincide with your Name number. Suppose your name number is 5. According to above rules you should buy a lottery ticket bearing number like 1895. Here the unit's digit is 5 which coincides with your name number 5. Again the ten's digit 95, added together and reduced to a single digit, is equal to 5 which itself is your Name number. Further when all the digits of the lottery ticket number are added up and reduced to a single digit, they give the final number 5, which again agrees with your Name number. Hence this lottery ticket should prove fortunate for those who are ruled by number 5.
- (d) You should buy such a lottery ticket on Wednesday which rules number 5.
- (e) Besides all this, if this lottery ticket is purchased on 5th, 14th or 23rd of the months, falling on Wed-

nesday, during the periods as mentioned in rule 3, the result will be most encouraging.

(10) You should observe the same rules as explained in paragraph 9 in case you want to purchase a lottery ticket number in which the first three numbers should score the first prize. Suppose your name number is 5. You should, therefore, buy a lottery ticket, bearing number like 27095. Here the unit's digit is 5 which coincides with your name number 5. Again the first three digits 095, added together and reduced to a single digit, are equal to 5 which itself is your Name or Lucky number. Further when all the digits of the lottery ticket number are added up and reduced to a single digit, they give the final number 5, like 2+7+0+9+5=23=2+3=5, which coincides with your Name number. Hence this lottery ticket should prove lucky for those who are ruled by number 5. Moreover you should buy such a lottery ticket on Wednesday which rules numbr 5. Besides all this, if this lottery ticket is purchased on 5th, 14th or 23rd of the months, falling on Wednesday, during the periods as mentioned in Rule 3, the result will be most astonishing.

(11) You should observe the same rules as explained in paragraphs 9 and 10 in case you want to purchase a lottery ticket number in which the first four digits or the first five digits or the first six digits and so on should score the first prize. If you hope to win the first prize should follow these rules strictly.

(12) Besides the above rules you can find out the terry ticket number, which may secure the first prize, referring to Friends number—Table No. 4.

CHAPTER VI.

Application of Numbers to Racing (Racing Numerology) (a) General

By racing, I mean horse-racing. Horse-racing, as we know it to day, is a modern institution, imported into this country by the sporting Britishers. Races are considered to be a delightful sport for the Kings and the Rich, considering the amount of money you require to indulge in it. But horse-racing is the king of sports too as every Tom, Dick and Harry make it a point to attend the races in preference to any other sport in progress at the same time.

Evils of Racing & Author's Opinion.

Races have not only ruined the Rich, but many a middle class and poor people have become pennyless within a very short time also. The hard-earned money is swept away in a moment, and suicides are also being committed in a number of cases. On the other hand, when money is got from Races, it is invariably utilised in different undesirable ways. These are the main reasons why going to races is generally considered to be inadvisable.

Majority of people are inclined to go to Races with the hope of getting some money. It is not at all wrong to earn money by any honest means, as money is the chief medium which brings about the desired goal in most cases.

Speculation is generally considered to be a bad thing. However it is no doubt bad if the same is done

beyond one's limit. Moreover, if you look around minutely, you will observe that practically each and every business in this world is being carried on, on some form of speculation. Hence it is not bad at all if you go to Races with the hope of getting money by backing on some sound foundation, and under one's own limits.

However, in view of the Evils of Racing as described above, it will not be wise to induce any body to fall into this line. But the Scientific principles and reliability in finding out the winners of Races by Racing Numerology have prompted the author to incorporate in this books the principles of "Racing Numerology" also for the benefit of readers. Attempts have been made to explain the theory clearly with actual examples in proof. However, I may warn the readers that the theory must be thoroughly mastered with the practical examples before investing any money.

The system of "Racing Numerology" is based upon the Occult Values of Numbers adopted by sages almost since the world was first habitable to reveal destiny. The Science of Numbers has been treated in different ways by different authors and I have also dealt with this Science in details in previous pages of this book. Here I shall discuss this Science in so far as it applies to Horse-Racing.

In India a child is named by the Occult Letter of the Zodiacal sign which is ruling at the time of its birth. This puts the life of the child in harmony with the laws of Nature. It is generally seen that the partitular names of the Kings, ships, etc., have different periodical rulings, resulting in success or failure in course of time. Race-Horses of the best class have also failed to do anything even in competition with the lower class. This is due to bad occult influence which falls on them due to inharmonious names given by their owners. As soon as their names are changed, they win at the very start. This demonstrates the fact that there was something peculiarly obstructive in the name. This obstruction of "The bad Occult influence" was removed by the mere change of the name.

Thus it is clear from the above discussion that the name of an animate or an inanimate object is materially affected by the subtle influence of different planets.

'Similarly favourable winning chances for horses, by their names alone, can be found out by the application of the Scientific principles of numbers, discussed in details in this book.

(b) How to find out the Probable winner in Horse-Race.

In chapter III of this book I have already given numerical values of alphabets and have also mentioned there in the full method of finding out your fate or name number. I have also told you of the numbers ruled by the planets in Chapter II. In the same Chapter I have also discussed the numbers ruling each week day. In this very Chapter I have given Table of Planetary Hours and Table of Planetary Periods. In Chapter III I have already given numerical values of months & dates under Table No. 3, captioned as "Months and Dates Fate Numbers". All these informations will be necessary to find out the probable winner in horse-race.

First Method of Finding Probable Winners in Horse-Race. Theory of winning Numbers

You may find out the probable winner in horse-race by carefully following the steps given below:—

- (i) Note the correct and actual Name of the Race as given in the Official Race Card. First of all find out the numerical value of the Full Name of Race as given in the Official Race Card by applying the alphabetical values given in Chapter III in the manner discussed there in.
- (ii) Note the correct Names of Horses as per the Official Race Card and find out the numerical value of name of each of the horses as discussed in Step No. (i).
- (iii) Note the correct Numbers of Horses as per the Official Race Card. Put the name value of each of the horses, as found out by Step No. II above, against its fixed number as per the Official Race Card.
- (iv) Note the date of the running of the race. You may find out the numerical value of date by referring to table of "Months and Dates Fate Numbers" given in Chapter III in the manner discussed there in.
- (v) Note the exact time of Sun-rise. You may find out the time of Sun-rise from any good Panchang or Ephemeris. By referring to our "World Time Clock", you may find out the time of sun-rise at any place in the world.
- (vi) Note the ruler of the day and also his number. I have already discussed this matter in Chapter No. II of this book.
- (vii) Note the planets ruling different hours from the exact time of sun rise. From this find out the planet

ruling the hour in which race is run. Please consult 'Table of Planetary Hours' given in Chapter II of this book.

- (viii) Make a list of sub-periods of four minutes along with their rulers from the time of sun-rise. From this find out the planet ruling the sub-period in which race is run. Please consult "Table of Planetary Sub-Periods of an hour" in Chapter II of this book,
 - (ix) Now add the following:—
 - (a) Numerical value of Name of Race—explained in Step (i).
 - (b) Numerical value of date of running the race—explained in Step (iv).
 - (c) Number of ruler of day—explained in Step (vi).
 - (d) Number of planet ruling the hour in which race is run—explained in Step (vii).
 - (e) Number of planet ruling the sub-period in which race is run—explained in Step (viii).
- (x) After adding all the above numbers given in Step (ix), reduce them to a single digit.
- (xi) Now consult "Table of Friends Number" given in Chapter III. Now see if the resultant single digit (arrived at by step 'x') is friend to numerical value of name of any horse. If there is any such horse, that horse will represent the probable winning horse. Moreover if the resultant single digit (arrived at by step 'x') is also friend to official number of such horse as per race card, then chances of this horse winning in race are the brightest.

I illustrate the above steps by means of Example.

Example:—On Saturday, the 4th November, 54 the race was run at 6-20 P. M., I. S. T. at Bombay with the name of Gatwick Plate. There were 20 good Arabs on the card. For simplicity sake we give below the official names and numbers of 5 horses only out of the 20.

Solution:— (i) Numerical value of the full name of Race-plate "Gatwick" is 2, calculated in the manner explained in Chapter III.

(ii) Now let us find out the numerical value of name of each of the horses, calculated in the manner explained in chapter III. For brevity sake we give below the numerical value of name of the above five horses only.

(iii) Note the correct numbers of Horses as per the Difficial Race Card against numerical value of name of Lorses as given in Step II.

- (iv) Now find out the numerical value of date of the running of the Race by referring to table of "Months and Dates Fate Numbers" given in Chapter III. This comes to 8.
- (v) The time of Sun-rise at Bombay on Saturday, the 4th November 54 is 7-0 A.M. as per our "World Time Clock."
- (vi) The ruler of day is Saturn and his number is 8.
- (vii) Sun rules the hour in which the race is run. For this refer to "Table of Planetary Hours" in Chapter II of this book. Sun's number is 1.
- (viii) Saturn rules the sub-period in which race is run. Saturn rules number 8.
- (ix) Now we add the numerical values of the following:—
- (a) Name of Race...... Gatwick =2 see step(i)
- (b) Date of running the race, 4th Nov.1954=8, (iv)
- (c) Ruler of day...... Saturn =8 ,, (vi)
- (d) Planet ruling the

hour, race is run Sun =1 ,, (vii)

(e) Planet ruling the sub-

period in which race is run...Saturn =8 ,, (viii)

Total 27

- (x) Reducing 27 to a single digit we get 9.
- (xi) Now let us refer to "Table of Friends Number" given in chapter III. See if the single digit 9 (arrived at by step 'x') is friend to numerical value of names of any of the horses (Refer to step 'ii' for numerical values of names of horses). Single digit 9 is friend to

numbers "4, 6, 7 and 8" per our "Table of Friend Number". Squire, having numerical value 7, is friend to number 9. Hence Squire represents the probable winning horse. Moreover Squire's official number "6" is also friend to resultant single digit 9. Hence the chances of Squire winning the race are the brightest.

Second Method of finding the Probable Winner in Horse-Race Theory of Winning Weights

Let us consider the question of weights to which great importance is attached in racing. The capacities of horses vary according to age, height, class and breed. If all the horses were to start level the best horse would always win and there would be no chances for betting. Hence the chances of the runners, good, bad and indifferent, should be equalised artificially by allotting them weights to be carried by each in keeping with its reputation for past performances and with other important facts. The weight so allotted includes everything that the horse carries on his back or body-the bridle, reins, saddle, stirrup and above all, the weight of the rider. If all this does not amount to the required, the deficiency is made up with lead sheets cleverly concealed in the saddle.

there are two kinds of races. There are "handicaps", and then there are "terms". In case of 'handicaps' an fficer, known as 'Handicapper', does the work of alloting the weight a horse is to carry. But in 'terms' races, animals carry weights according to a fixed scale, these added and allowances deducted; the scale is penalties

either W. A. or W. I. The former denotes weight for age, while the latter represents weight for inches.

It is generally considered by students of form that a load of 15 pounds on the back of a horse makes a difference of one second in the time of running or 3 lengths in the distance in races upto a mile. For instance, Husky and Cintra, starting on equal terms, finish the five furlongs race in one minute, Husky a length behind Cintra. Then, as per the theory of weight, the next time they meet in race, their chances will be equal if Cintra is saddled with 3 pounds more than Husky. Thus the form-experts are always in a battle of wit with the handicapper.

However, I give you here a method of determining winning weights, without any preamble It is very simple. I hope that you will find the method better than other methods. No elaborate calculatios are needed except additions and subtractions.

Here is the formula for calculating the winning weight:—

$$d = \frac{(x-9) 4 n}{81} + 4$$

Here X is the scale, that is, the difference in pounds between the two extreme weights, viz., the top weight and the bottom weight of the runners;

N is the numerical value of the planetary subperiods;

D is the difference in pounds which, deducted from top weight or added to bottom weight, gives two weights one of which is that of the likely winner.

On Saturday, the 4th November 1954, at 6-20 P. M. I. S. T., the Gatwick plate was run at Bombay. There were twenty good Arabs on the card, of which only two declined. Husky was the top-weight, 10st. 5lbs., and Cintra was the bottom-weight, 9st. 5lbs. The sub-period value was calculated as under:

Now as per table of "Planetary Hours" given in Chapter II you will find that the race was run in the blanetary hour of Sun. Further by referring to table of "P lanetary Sub-periods of hour" in the same chapter you will find that the race was run in the sub-period of saturn. Hence the numerical equivalent of Planetary hour and Sub-period is 1+8=9. The scale was 10st. 5lbs.-9st. slbs.=1st.=14lbs. Substituting these values in the formula, bu have:

$$d = \frac{(14 - 9)4 \times 9}{81}$$

Subtracting 6 lbs. from 10st. 5lbs. and adding it to 9st. 5lbs., the top and bottom weights respectively; you have 9st. 13 lbs. and 9st. 11 lbs. as the weights indicated of the likely winners.

Now Scanning through your card for horses carrying. these or the nearest weights, you find the following:

According to our rules Squire and Hamiar carried the weights indicated of the likely winners. But Hamiar was scratched out. Of the remaining three Squire won. Squire carried weights indicated of the likely winner.

Note: -So by both the methods Squire has the brightest chances of winning the race. Squire came out successful in race as per the official announcement.

(c) Some Important Suggestions on Racing

Besides the above two methods I suggest to you following very important points which you should keep in mind on the race day. You should use these points intelligently to find out the probable winner.

- (1) See some Hindi or Urdu Panchang and find out Nakshtra, the Moon is transitting on the race day. If the Moon transits any of the following Nakshtras: Rohini, Mirgasira, Pushya and Magha, then it is certain that some dark flukes will win on that day.
- (2) If the Race day falls on New Moon's day (Umavas), the horses carrying bottom weights will proba-

bly score wins, But if the race day falls on Full Moon's day (Poornima), the horses carrying top weights will score wins. Specially if New Moon's day occurs on Tuesday and Moon and Mars make conjunction on that day, then horses carrying bottom weights have the brightest chances to win. Again if the Full Moon's day falls on Saturday, Sun or Moon making conjunction with Saturn then horses carrying top-weights have golden chances to win.

(3) On the 6th, the 7th, the 8th day from New Moon's day, if Moon forms conjunction with Jupiter, then the horses carrying middle-weights will score wins.

Again on the 6th, 7th, the 8th day from Full Moon's day, if Moon forms conjunction with Venus, then the horses carrying middle-weights will score wins.

- (4) Please refer to our "Six Years' Astronomical Bhartiya Ephemeris-1955 to 1960 A.D" by Pt. Ganga Pd., Jyotishacharya, Morar (M. B.). This contains longitudes of the planets according to Sayan System. From the longitudes of the planets given in this Ephemeris, subtract 23°15' to get longitudes of the planets according to Nirayana or Indian system. Now see if any of the following occurs on the Race day:-
 - (a) If the Sun transits Aries, Taurus or Capricorn, numbers 1 and 4 are likely to win.
 - (b) If the Sun transits Aries, Taurus or Capricorn and the degree of the longitude is either 4° or 10° or 13°, then it is certain that numbers 4, 10 or 13 will score many wins on that day. But if the longitude of the Sun

is neither 4°, nor 10° nor 13° then Nos. 4, 10 and 13 will score some wins.

- (e) If the Sun transits Leo, Scorpio or Pisces and the degree of the longitude is either 4° 10° or 13°, numbers 4, 10 or 13 will score many wins on that day.
- (d) If the Moon transits either Taurus or Cancer on the race day and longitude of Moon is 2° or 7°, or 11° or 16°, numbers 2, 7, 11 or 16 will be likely winners in many races.
- (e) If Mercury transits either Gemini or Virgo on the race day and if the longitude of Mercury is 5° or 14°, numbers 5 and 14 have brightest chances to win.
- (f) If Venus transits either Pisces or Taurus or Libra on the race day and if the longitude of Venus is either 6° or 15°, numbers 6 & 15 will be likely winners in many races.
- (g) If Mars transits either Capricorn or Aries or Scorpio and if the longitude of Mars is either 9° or 18°, numbers 9 and 18 have brightest chances to score many wins.
- (h) If Jupiter transits either Cancer or Sagittarius or Pisces and if the longitude of Jupiter is either 3 ° or 12°, numbers 3 and 12 will score many wins.
- (i) If Saturn transits either Libra or Capricorn or Aquarius and if the longitude of Saturn is either 8° or 17°, numbers 8 and 17 will be likely winners in many races on that day.
- N. B.—I have given above some practical suggestions about the planets transitting various zodiacal signs. Suppose at the time of the race, Sun transits Aries and

the longitude of Sun is 4°. I have already told you that numbers 1, 4 or 10 are probable winners in many cases. But in this race if number 1 does not run, you should back numbers 4 and 10. But if the number 4 gets the Draw number either of 1 or 4 or 10, number 4 is then sure winner. But if the number 4 gets the draw number of 5 and number 10 gets the draw number of 4, you should back number 10 as both numbers 10 and 4 are the Sun's numbers. In case of the other planets transitting various zodiacal signs, either of their exaltation or their own houses, if the horses carrying those numbers do not run, you should back these horses carrying their Draw numbers.

(5) Please refer to our "Six Years' Astronomical Bhartiya Ephemeris—1955 to 1960 A.D." by Pt. Ganga Prasad, Jyotishacharya, Morar (M. B.). This contains mutual aspects between the planets along with exact times during each day. If Square or Opposition aspect is formed during the race-time, it is certain that a fluke horse will win the race. But if Trine or Sextile aspect is formed, then some favourite horse will score the win.

You may guess the probable winning numbers by beserving the following broad hints:—

- (a) If a Square or Opposition aspect is formed between the Sun and the Moon during the race-time, the numbers of the Sun and the Moon—1, 4 and 2, 7 will be probable winners.
- (b) If a Square or Opposition aspect is formed between the Sun and Jupiter during the race-time, the numbers of the Sun and Jupiter—1, 4 and 3 will be pronable winners.

- (c) Similarly if a Square or Opposition aspect is formed between the Sun and any other planet, their numbers should be supported for a win.
- (d) If a Trine or Sextile aspect is formed between the Sun and any other planet their numbers should score probable winners.
- (e) If there is a Square or Opposition aspect between the Moon and Mercury during the race-time, their numbers 2, 7 and 5 will score win.
- (f) If a Square or Opposition aspect is formed between the Moon and Mars during the race-time, the numbers of Moon and Mars—2, 7 and 9 will be probable winners.
- (g) If a Trine aspect is formed between the Moon and Mercury during the race-time, the numbers of the Moon and Mercury—2, 7 and 5 will score wins if any number is a favourite.
- (h) If a Square or Trine aspect is formed between Venus and Mars on the race-day, the numbers of Venus and Mars—6 and 9 will be probable winning numbers.
- N. B.—I have not given the effects of all aspects between all planets. Rather I have given broad hints to enable you to arrive at some judgment.

CHAPTER VII

Application of Numbers to American Cotton Futures

(a) General—This chapter mainly deals with cotton trade. In the beginning we should know all details of cotton trade.

The cotton is best cultivated in those places where land is fertile, seeds are best available and the climatic conditions are favourable to cotton-growing. If the farmer is clever, he can produce even 200 Ratal cotton in an acre of land. America leads the cotton producing countries. Next comes India. Egypt, China and Russia occupy the third and fourth places respectively. Egyptian cotton ranks the first in quality. American and Indian cotton are second and third rate in quality.

America leads in cotton production. America is also the biggest business centre of cotton-production and trade. Businessmen should note that there are four chief centres of cotton trade—America, Europe, England and India.

We come to know from a study of Geography and Astrology that season differs in every country. Here we should note down the difference in American and Indian climate. Rainy season begins in India in the months of July-August, while in America the rainy season starts in March-April. The sowing season also differs in the same way.

In America 100 future = 1 Cent
100 Cents = 1 Dollar
20 Dollars = 1 Rial

When future costs 1071, at that time 21 Ratal cotton costs 1 Dollar.

The prices ruling in America at the time of opening of American Market are known as "Opening-prices" in India. But the prices ruling in America at the time of closing of American Market are known as "Closing-prices" in India. The future Opening and Closing transactions are done at various places in India—Calcutta, Bombay, Patna, Indore, Kanpur, etc.

In future transactions businessmen deal on figures-1 to 9 and 10 to 100. Speculators usually pays Rs. 9/for one figure of Rupee one. This is known as future or speculation-transaction.

(b) Rules of Speculation (Future--Transactions)

Now-a-days people usually deal more in Future transactions than in Ready transactions. But only the lucky few make money out of future transactions. We usually receive letters from various businessmen that they could not gain out of future transactions due to one reason or the other. Hence one should deal in future transactions only when there are such yogas (in native's horoscope) which may yield him money through future transactions or native is passing through such "Vinshottari Dasha" or "Ashtotari Dasha" where the Mahadasha of the ruler of Second or Eleventh House exists or planets, ruling Second or Eleventh House, occupy the First, Fifth and Ninth House of Horoscope or the same planets occupy the First, Fourth, Seventh and Tenth House or the benefic planets-Jupiter, Mercury or Venus—forms Inter-Dasha

with the planets ruling the Second or Eleventh House. Those persons who enter future transactions at the time of malefic planets lose all their wealth. Speculation is the foremost enemy. This has ruined a large number of wealthy persons. Many have lost their lives even. Hence it is my sincere advice that you should not deal in future transactions so long as you are earning in some Ready transactions.

Now-a-days people all over the world are dealing in future transactions. In America and England you will find top-most speculators. But these people understand the principles and rules of speculation very well, while most of our Indian businessmen are ignorant of the rules and principles of speculation, rather they do it relying on blind faith of some Mahatamas and saints who do not know even the meaning of speculation. They realise their follies when they lose their every thing. In America, speculators enter future transactions on sound basis and calculations. They deal on short margins and not on wide margins as Indians do. Indians want to become rich overnight by speculation. This is the only folly they do.

However, you may find out figures of speculation by applying the sound principles of Astrology given in some standard book. We enumerate in this book some of the outstanding principles of astrology in this field. You may yourself find out figures of speculation by applying the principles of this book. You may also consult some learned astrologers in this respect. You should first ask the astrologer as to whether planets in your hose

rescope are favourable in gaining money by speculation and then ask him for figures of speculation Pandit Ganga Prasad, Jyotishacharya, Morar has a world-wide reputation in this respect. You may consult him on such and other allied points reliably. If you speculate on sound principles, applying the rules given in this book, you are sure to gain in speculation. You may earn at least Rs. 500/- to Rs. 600/- per month. But you must keep separately a sum of Rs. 300/- to Rs. 400/- before entering in speculation. I may warn you that you should always try to speculate on short margins only except when the conditions are most favourable to deal on wide margins.

(c) Planetary Aspects helping acquisition of Wealth by Speculation.

- (a) A native will become rich by dealing in Silver, Cotton, Clothes, Yarn, Silk, Mills and Factories, if zodiacal signs—Taurus and Pisces and the planet—Venus occupy Second House of his horoscope.
- (b) A man will become rich easily by speculation, Lotteries, Cotton future, Gambling if Mercury, Venus and Saturn occupy the fourth house in zodiacal signs—Taurus, Cancer and Libra in his horoscope.
- (c) A man will gain wealth from Horse-Racing, Lotteries and hidden source if Sun and Jupiter occupy the fifth house in zodiacal signs—Aries, Cancer, Leo, Sagittarius—in his horoscope.
- (d) A man will gain wealth all of a sudden by future transactions if either Jupiter or Mercury or Venus

occupies the Eighth house in zodiacal signs—Taurus, Cancer, Virgo and Pisces—in his horoscope.

- (e) A native will get wealth from the business of Iron shares, mustard seeds, Gwar, Gur if either Mercury or Jupiter or Venus occupies the Ninth house in zodiacal signs—Cancer, Virgo, Pisces.
- (f) A native will become millionaire by dealing in shares, Iron, Machines, Oil, Alsi and Mustard seeds, groundnuts, blankets, wool, goat, buffaloes if Saturna occupies the Tenth house in zodiacal signs—Libra and Capricorn.
- (g) The man in whose horoscope either Moon, Mercury or Saturn occupies the Eleventh house in zodiacal signs—Taurus, Virgo, Libra-will get huge amount of wealth from the business of Motors, Mills, Clothes, Jewels, Steamer or Hidden source, Lottery, Tata Deferred and Iron shares. The man having above yogas may become proprietor of Big Factories and Mills.
- (h) If Mercury, being the ruler of Second houses occupies the Eleventh house, then this yoga will give the native good amount of wealth from future transactions.
- (i) If Rulers of First, Second and Eighth house occupy the Eleventh house, then the native will gain wealth from future transactions.
- (j) Moon in Eighth house in zodiacal signs—Tauru and Aquarius—without being watched by Malefic planets will yield the native good amount of wealth from American future transactions.
- (k) The native will gain from forward business if Jupiter in Pisces occupies either the Second or Seventh or Eleventh house.

Even degrees of Sun's position denote fall and odd degrees of Sun's position denote rise; while odd degrees of Moon's position denote fall and even degrees of Moon's position denote rise.

Take Sun's position from opening of market (I.S.T. 10-30 A.M.) (Nirayan system). Take Moon's position from closing of market (8-30 P. M.) The numerical values of zodiacal signs of Sun and Moon will be same. The numerical values of zodiacal signs are given below. These are calculated as per method explained in Chapter III.

Rule of Forecasting Daily Rise and Fall in Prices. of Commodities and Shares by First System

We have written above the Dhruwanks of the articles to see rise and fall—1 Sankranti, 2 Days, 3 Months, 4 Tithi, 5 Nakshtra, 6 Yog and 7 the name of articles.

Add up all these seven numbers and multiply the added figures by 7 and divide the result by 4. We should consider the rise and fall upon the remainder. If the remainder is 1, then it will be rise, while if the remainder comes 2, then forecast a little rise. But if the remainder comes 3, then it will remain unchanged i.e., stationary. Further if the remainder comes 4 i.e., 0, then you may foretell fall and there will be a loss in money matter.

N. B.-Besides the above if any thing about the Sorat is to be predicted or found out and how many lickets of the Soratare to be out, then first make it certain and find out which number is to come. This will be exactly found out. We are giving special Dhruwanks for all types of shares along with other articles in every market. Please refer to our Mahalaxmi Panchang for Dhruwanks.

Rules of Forecasting Daily Rise and Fall in Prices of Commodities and Shares by Second System

The day on which you want to know we should calculate as under:-

- (i) Sankranti Dhruwank.
- (ii) Days ,
- (iii) Tithi
- (iv) Nakshtra,
- (v) City
- (vi) Articles, ,, i.e., the thing about which we want to know.

We should add all these Dhruwanks and divide the result by 9. The remainder will decide the rise and fall. If the remainder is 0, 1, 3, 7 then prices will rise and if the remainder is 2, 4, 5, 8 the prices will fall, but if the remainder comes to 6 the prices will remain unchanged.

N. B.-In American Cotton Future add all the above six Dhruwanks and then divide the result by 100. The remainder will decide the rise and fall. If the remainder is even number, then the prices will rise. But if the remainder is an odd number, prices will fall.

Example 1. You have to find out whether prices of Gold and Silver will rise or fall on 18th November 54 in Bombay Market.

Solution:-From our Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang or some other Panchang, find out Sankranti, Day, Tithi and Nakshtra on 18th November 54.

Now we note Dhruwanks of Sankranti, Day, Tithi, Nakshtra, etc., as below from Second System of Dhruwank Deepak given above:—

Divide 3569 by 9, the remainder is 5. This denotes there will be fall in prices of silver on 18th November 54 on the basis of rules given above. Again divide 3035 by 9, the remainder comes 2. This again denotes there will be fall in prices of Gold also on 18th November 54 as per rule given above.

Example 2. Find out the rise and fall in figure of Cotton Future New York on 30th November 54.

Solution- From our Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang or some other Panchang find out Sankranti, Day, Tithi and Nakshtra on 30th November 54 and note down their Dhruwanks as below from Second System of Dhruwant: Deepak given in previous pages.

Rule:--(a) If the tithi on the day in question lasts between 1-30 Ghatis (Indian Clock-time of 24 minutes in one ghati), then deduct the result arrived at by Table No. 6 from the result arrived at by Table No. 7. The net result will indicate the rise or fall in prices in Rupees and annas.

(b) But if the tithi lasts between 31-60 Ghatis, then add the results arrived at by both tables Nos. 6 & 7. The net result will indicate the rise or fall in prices in Rupees and annas.

Explanation:—From example 1 on Page 101, you find that the remainder in case of Silver is 5 which denotes a fall in prices of Silver on 18th November 1954. But this does not indicate fall in prices in Rupees and annas. We can find out fall or rise in prices in Rupees and annas from Remainder by referring to Tables Nos. 6&7.

Now refer to date 18th in Table No. 6 against Remainder 5, you will get number 1, indicating fall of Anna 1 in prices.

Also refer to date 18th in Table No. 7 against Remainder number 5, you will get number $2\frac{1}{2}$, indicating fall of Rs. $2\frac{1}{2}$ in prices.

But the tithi Navmi on 18th November 1954 lasts for 53 Ghatis. This means that we should follow Rule (b) given above i.e., add up the results arrived at by both Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Hence we will add up the results arrived at by both Tables Nos. 6 and 7 as above. The net result will be a fall in prices of Silver by Rs. 2/8/- + -/1/- = Rs. 2/9/- on 18th November 1954.

Similarly we should predict the fall in prices of Gold in Rupees and annas in example 1 on page 101.

From this example you find that the Remainder number in case of gold is 2 which denotes a fall in prices of Gold on 18th November 1954. But this does not indicate fall in prices in Rupees and annas. We can find out fail or rise in prices in Rupees and annas from Remainder number by referring to Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Now refer to date 18th in Table No. 6 against Remainder number 2, you will get number 3, indicating fall of annas 3 in prices.

Also refer to date 18th in Table No. 7 against Remainder number 2 you will get number 1, indicating fall of Re. 1/- in prices.

But the tithi-Navmi-on 18th November 1954 lasts for 53 Ghatis. This means that we should follow Rule (b) given above i.e., add up the results arrived at by both Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Hence we will add up the results arrived at by Tables Nos. 6 and 7 as above. The net result will be a fall in prices of Gold by Re. 1/- + -/3/- = Re. 1/3 on 18th November 1954.

Example 1,—You have to find out whether prices of cotton will rise or fall on 10th December 54 in Bombay Market.

Solution:—From our Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang or some other Panchang, find out Sankranti, Day, Tithi and Nakshtra on 10th December 54 and then find out their

Divide 3787 by 9 the remainder is 7. This denotes there will be rise in prices of cotton on 10th December 1954 on the basis of rule given on page 100.

But this does not indicate rise in prices in Rupees and annas. We can find out rise in prices of cotton in Rupees and annas from Remainder by referring to Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Now refer to date 10th in Table No. 6 against Remainder No. 7, you will get number 1½, indicating rise of Annas 1½ in prices.

Also refer to date 10th in Table No. 7 against Remainder number 7, you will get number 4, indicating rise of Rs. 4/- in prices.

But the Tithi Pratipada on 10th December 1954 lasts for 50 Ghatis. This means that we should follow Rule (b) given on page 105, i.e., add up the results arrived at by Tables Nos. 6 & 7. Hence we add up the results arrived at by both Tables Nos. 6 and 7 as above. The net result will be a rise in prices of cotton by Rs. 4/-+-/1/6 = Rs. 4/1/6 on 10th December 1954.

Example 2.—You have to find out whether prices of Tata Ordinary Shares will rise or fall on 6th December 1954 in Bombay market.

Solution.—From our Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang or some other Panchang, find out Sankranti, Day, Tithi, and Nakshtra on 6th December 1954 and then find out their Dhruwanks as below from Second System of Dhruwank Deepak.

Sankranti = Vrikshik = 782 Day = Monday **≈** 850 Tithi = Ekadashi = 278Nakshtra = Revati = 174 City = Bombay Article = Tata Ordinary = 457 2550

Divide 2550 by 9, the remainder is 3. This denote there will be rise in prices of Tata Ordinary Shares on 6th December 54 on the basis of rules given on page 100. But this does not indicate rise in prices in Rupees and annas. We can find out rise in prices of Tata Ordinary Shares in Rupees and annas from Remainder number by referring to Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Now refer to date 6th in Table No. 6 against Remainder number 3, you will get number 1, indicating rise of anna 1 in prices.

Also refer to date 6th in Table No. 7 against Remainder number 3, you will get number $4\frac{1}{2}$, indicating rise of Rs. 4/8/- in prices.

But the Tithi Ekadashi on 6th December 1954 lasts for 33 Ghatis. This means that we should follow rule (b) given on page 105, i.e., add up the results arrived at by Tables Nos. 6 and 7. Hence we add up the results arrived at by both Tables Nos. 6 and 7 as above. The net result will be a rise in prices of Tata Ordinary Shares by Rs. 4/8/- + -/1/- = Rs. 4/9/- on 6th December 1954.

Example 3.—You have to find out whether prices of Jute will rise or fall on 13th December 54 in Calcutta market.

Solution:—From our Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang or some other Panchang find out Sankranti, Day, Tithi and Nakshtra on 13th December 54 and then find out their Dhruwanks as below from Second System of Dhruwank Deepak.

Sankranti = Vrikshik = 782 Day Monday **≈** 850 Tithi = Chaturthi = 574 Nakshtra = Pushya = 525 City = Calcutta ₩. 7 Article = Jute = 747 3485

Divide 3485 by 9, the remainder is 2. This denotes that there will be fall in prices of Jute on 13th December 1954 on the basis of rule referred to in previous example. But this does not indicate fall in prices in Rupees and annas. We can find out fall in prices of Jute in Rupees and annas from Remainder number by referring to Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Now refer to date 13th in Table No. 6 against Remainder number 2, you will get number 4, indicating fall of Annas 4 in prices.

Also refer to date 13th in Table No. 7 against Remainder No. 2, you will get number 3, indicating fall of Rs. 3/- in prices.

But the tithi Chaturthi on 13th December 1954 lasts for 32 Ghatis. This means that we should follow Rule (b) referred to in previous example, i.e., add up the results arrived at by Tables Nos. 6 and 7. Hence we add up the results arrived at by both Tables Nos. 6 and 7 as above. The net result will be a fall in prices of Jute by Rs. 3/-7+-14/-= Rs. 3/4/- on 13th December 1954.

Example 4—You have to find out whether prices of Cotton will rise or fall on 2nd and 3rd February 1955 in Bombay market.

Solution—From our Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang or some other Panchang find out Sankranti, Day, Tithi and Nakshtra on 2nd and 3rd February 55 and then find out their Dhruwanks as below from Second System of Dhruwank Deepak.

Divide 2606 by 9 and 3020 by 9, the remainders in both the cases are 5. The remainders denote that there will be fall in prices of Cotton on 2nd and 3rd February 55 on the basis of rule referred to in previous examples.

But this does not indicate fall in prices in Rupees and annas. We can find out fall in prices of Cotton in Rupees and annas from Remainder number by referring to Tables Nos. 6 and 7.

Now refer to date 2nd in Table No. 6 against Remainder number 5, you will get number 3½, indicating fall of annas 3½ in prices on 2nd February 55. Again refer to date 3rd in Table No. 6, against Remainder number 5, you will get number 4, indicating fall of Annas 4 in prices on 3rd February 55.

Also refer to date 2nd in Table No. 7 against Remainder Number 5, you will get number 3½, indicating fall of Rs. 3½ in prices on 2nd February 55. Again refer to date 3rd in Table No. 7 against Remainder number 5, you will get number 4, indicating fall of Rs.4 in prices on 3rd February 55.

But the tithi Dashami on 2nd February 55 lasts for 27 Ghatis, while the tithi Ekadashi on 3rd February 55 lasts for 21 Ghatis. This means that we should follow Rule (a) given on page 105, i.e., deduct the result arrived at by Table No. 6 from the result arrived at by Table No. 7. Hence we deduct the result arrived at by Table No. 6 from the result arrived at by Table No. 7 on both the dates. The net result will indicate that there will be fall in prices of Cotton by Rs. $3\frac{1}{2}$ = Rs. 3/4/6 on 2nd February 55, while there will

be fall in prices of Cotton by Rs. 4 - As. 4 = Rs. 3/12/- on 3rd February 55.

CHAPTER IX

Application of Numbers to gain wealth all of a Sudden

The whole world is facing an economic crisis in these years. India is not an exception to it. Everybody is after obtaining more and more money for his earning is quite meagre and shy as compared to his ever-growing demands. His necessities are not fulfilled with his small income. From his spoken name and from his name which ought to have been according to his birth zodiacal sign, we may find out his fate number as below.

Now refer to Table No. 1 in Chapter III and calculate numerical values of the names of Ramkishore and Roop Lal as below:—

Thus we get number 38. The man of this name will have 38th year in his life as the best of all. By adding the digits of this number (38) we get (3+8= 1=2)2. Hence 2nd month i.e., February will be the best month of this year in his life. Further 3rd, 12th, 21st and 8th 17th, 26th dates of this month will be the luckiest of all dates. On these dates of the month he will get wealth all of a sudden. From Sunday the 3rd Day i.e., Tuesday and the 8th day i.e., Sunday are the best of all.

But Ram Kishore is now running in 31st year of his life in year 1955. We have to see how 1955 will be. The Lucky number for Ram Kishore is (3+8=11=2) 2.

1955 is equal to 2 which is equal to 2, his fate number. Hence 1955 will be equally profitable for him. But as compared to his year 38th which falls in 1961 (equivalent to 8), his 31 year falling in 1955 will be less profitable to him. This is because 1961=8 which is four times that of number 2, his fate number.

Second month from the beginning of the year, 1955 i.e., February is the best month of the year and 3rd, 12th, 21st and 8th, 17th, 26th dates of this month are the most favourable dates. Tuesday and Sunday are the luckiest days. We should see on these dates whether Tuesday or Sunday falls on either of the dates. 8th February 1955 falls on Tuesday. Hence 8th is the most fortunate date for purchasing Lottery Ticket, Competing in Horse-Race or purchasing Cotton Future.

Now we have to find out the number we should purchase to fetch good amount. Serial Number 2 of Ram Kishore i.e., 556375739 or of Roop Lali.e., 377244 will be the most favourable numbers in Lottery.

But we have told you that 38th year of his life is best year. We have to find out the fate number of the 38th year. From the digits written under Roop Lal, Serial number 3rd i.e., 15968 is the best of all for him and for Ram Kishore Serial number 8, i.e, 341 is best of all the numbers for Lottery Ticket.

For Cotton Future in 31st year (5+5+6+3+7+5+7+3+9=50=5) 5 and (3+7+7+2+4+4=27=9) 9 are the most useful. Opening number 59 and Closing number 95 are the best of all.

This book has been prepared for commercial astrologers & businessmen in particular and public in general. Future transactions are held not only in India, but also in foreign countries. Usually businessmen carry on their trades according to their own calculations of teji and mandi. Till the publication of this book there was practically no book which may help businessmen in their trade. The planets do influence, rather dominate over and govern the Commercial market. The value of any commodity mostly depends on two factors: Supply and Demand. If a commodity is in plentitude, the value of that commodity

depreciates. But if there is scarcity of a commodity its prices appreciate, while if the demand is poor, the prices fall. But when the supply increases or falls? This depends on the good or bad harvest. But the question is when the harvest is good or bad? For this question we must refer to planetary laws. Planets act and react on one another in the atmosphere. On a Full Moon's day high tides are created in the sea owing to its intense attraction. Similarly planets affect fall and rise of value, crops, products and markets. The economic factors governing prices are only apparent causes. The primary cause is reflected by planets. If major planets are in good aspects, the prices would rise, while the prices would fall if major planets are in bad aspects. Thus the commercial markets are controlled by the celestial bodies with their positions and aspects in the heaven. Those businessmen, who will know the name of commodities ruled by each planet and zodiacal sign, will better control the market. Special features of this book are:

Zo-

diacal signs showing Teji and Mandi. Ruling planets indicating Teji and Mandi. (k) Effects of Aspects of Fast planets on market prices, (l) Effects of Aspects of the slow and ponderous planets on market prices.(m)Eclipse and their effects on Market,(n) Practical application of 110 Astrological rules explained, (o) Outstanding Astrological yogas helping success in business. (p) Monthly Market Forecast of prices of Gold, Silver and cotton from 1955 A. D. to 1960 A. D.

This book is not confined to any particular year, but the same is useful forever.

In this book we have illustrated by examples how the astrological rules explained in this book are applied in practice and how far they are correct.

As explained on page 9 of this book Venus and Jupiter rule Jute. As per Shree Mahalaxmi Panchang Samvat 2012, Venus transits in Pisces and Jupiter transits in Gemini on 18th April, 1955. Thus Jupiter forms a Trine aspect with Venus. On Page 16th of this book we have described both Pisces and Gemini as signs of Mandi. On page 12 we have mentioned that Trine aspect denotes mandi. So long as Jupiter transits in Gemini, there will be fall in prices. Hence there will be one-sided fall in prices of Jute B. T. between 18th April and 3rd May 55. Jute B. T. prices fell from Rs. 124/- to Rs. 110/- by 3rd May 55. Thus there was a fall of Rs. 14/- in prices.

Calculated World Standard Time

There are a large numbers of Panchangs published every year in India. But there is difference in Sun-rise, Sun-set, Geocentric Noon-time and the length of day in every Panchang, because these Panchangs are not calculated afresh every year. There is variation of 15 Kalas in Sun's position every year—some year Sun's position increases, while in other year the same decreases. This variation is balanced in the leap year only. With the variation in Sun's position every year there should also be variation in Sun-rise, Sun-set and Geocentric Noontime. Hence the astronomers must toke into account this variation every year for calculating Sun-rise, Sunset and Geocentric Noon-time upto seconds. This will enable them to prepare correct horoscope.

We have compiled this book to enable astronomers to calculate Sun-rise, Sun-set, Geocentric Noon-time and length of day upto seconds every year for any place in World with the help of Latitude and Longitude of that place. Ascendant of any place may also be found out with this book.
